## Summer School 2026

High School students under the age of 19 must have the prerequisite course(s). It is highly recommended that students under the age of 19 discuss their Summer School registration with their school counsellor to ensure they have the prerequisite course and that their choices for 2026-2027 are updated to reflect their plan for taking a course during Summer School.

These courses provide 60 hours of classroom instruction and extensive daily homework/study time. Students taking these courses are expected to attend all sessions. A few classes require textbooks, which the instructor will hand out at the beginning of the course. Textbooks must be returned to the instructor immediately before or after the final assessment. There may be a cost to replace a textbook if it is lost or not returned once Summer School has ended.
