# SASKATOON INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION

## SCHOOL FEES

Each school charges fees. School fee invoices will be sent to students and families after each semester has begun.

Each school charges its own fees by type and activity. The below fees are approximate to help you in your planning.

Student Activity Fee/SRC Fee	\$15-25	
Lunch Supervision Fee	\$100	per year for elementary students
Lunch Supervision Fee	\$50	per year for high school students
Locker padlock	\$10-13	only if student has a locker
Yearbook (optional)	\$35-47	students can opt out if they do not want one
Graduation (Gr 12 only)	\$60-70	cap & gown, graduation ceremony

## COURSE FEES

Students have many options for all kinds of elective courses. Some of these come with additional fees to cover materials,

travel and other course-related expenses. Higher level courses may have higher fees. Below are ranges to help you plan.

Special Physical Education Classes	\$100-\$150	to cover transportation, equipment, facilities
Physical Education or Wellness	\$30-40	Gr 9 and sometimes Gr 10 have uniforms
Visual Arts	\$20-40	may be more for Advanced or Studio Art
Welding, Machining, Mechanics	\$40-60	depends on level and projects
Construction/Woodworking	\$40-70	depends on level and projects
Clothing, Design, Sewing	\$25-40	depends on level and projects
Foods/Commercial Cooking	\$40-60	depends on level and projects
Photography, Graphic Arts	\$30-50	depends on level and projects
Band	\$50-60	add'l fees for instrument rental, trips, uniform
Dance, Music, Musical Theatre	\$30-50	costumes may be additional
Drafting, Computer Design, Robotics	\$20-40	depends on level and projects
