The Lakeview experience

- Prekindergarten to Grade 8
- Morning or Afternoon everyday kindergarten
- About 650 students – roughly half English, half French
- Diverse population – 30 countries, 70 different languages
- Large outdoor play structures
- School wide assemblies and spirit days
- Class field trips – parent volunteers always encouraged to join
- School Community Council for parents to join
- Optional Kinder-care (daycare) for kindergarten students
- Optional Before/After school care for k-8 students



French Immersion - L'immersion française

Goals of our Program:

- Comprehensive **education** in French,
- Develop excellent **language skills**, in French and English
- Give students the ability to communicate effectively in Canada's **two official languages**.



Upon completing the program, students can:

- Pursue **post-secondary education** and/or **employment** in both French and English,
- Possess an **understanding** of global perspectives on **cultures and peoples**, including their own.

- 6-12





Extended school day program purpose

- To aid parents who require childcare because they are working, attending classes or other activities.
- To provide safe, caring, and secure childcare with meaningful activities for the school community.
- To provide children the opportunity grow & develop their friendships with peers through positive interaction.



Kinder-Care Program

- The Kinder-Care Program is a learning and a paid daycare program for kindergarten aged students registered at Lakeview.
- Children can attend on a full time or part time basis.
- Children attend opposite times of their kindergarten class.
- Some of the activities we do each day include learning nursery rhymes, letters, numbers, our community, arts, crafts, and reading. We also use a portion of our day for physical activities and social interactions with classmates. We are a part of the school culture where the Kinder-Care students attend assemblies and other activities that take place in the school.
- The 2026/2027 School Year marks 23 years that the Kinder-Care program has been in operation at our school.
- The emphasis is on encouraging constructive use of leisure time in a safe and caring environment.
- This program is led by an adult hired by Mr. Williams.



Before and After School Programs

- The Before & After School Program is open to all k-8 students. The hours are 7:30-9:00am & 3:30-6:00pm.
- The program is run out of the same classroom as kinder-Care.
- Children can attend on a full time or part time basis.
- The program includes a variety of activities such as free playtime, crafts, sports and games, cooking, going to the gym and going outside when the weather is nice.
- This program is led by Mr. Williams and some additional staff after school.



- We are sometimes open for full days during PD/Planning Days and 3-Way Conferences.
- The only time the program is closed during all breaks, STAT holidays and summer.

Next Steps for extended day program

- Registration forms as well as the programs Policy Manual is found in the folder you received tonight.
- Fill out the registration forms and return them as soon as you can. Preferably by the Kindergarten sneak peek in May.
- Forms can be dropped off at the school or emailed to lesdpwilliams@hotmail.com
- Registration fee will be collected in September 2026.
- Registration can be at any time throughout the year. It is important that if you know you will utilize the program to register early for planning for staff in the fall.

Registration

- ✓ Your child must be 5 years old by **December 31, 2026** to be eligible.
(Born in 2021)
- ✓ All families who are not **Canadian citizens must visit the Newcomer Student Centre** to complete the registration form. This includes students who are permanent residents as well as those whose parents have a work/study permit.



- ✓ Register between now and May. Indicate AM or PM preference.
