Saskatoon Public Schools launches refreshed websites for improved, accessible user experience

Saskatoon Public Schools has launched refreshed division and school websites, providing families, students, staff, and the community with a familiar experience on a modern platform. The update focuses on clearer navigation, faster access to popular tools, and features that support users across devices.

While the site's overall structure will feel familiar, the platform has been updated to current web standards for 2025. The enhancements are designed to help visitors quickly find what they need without relearning how to move around the site.

What's new:

- **Translation feature:** A built-in translation tool supports access for diverse audiences.
- **Faster access to key tools:** Popular resources such as Edsby, Calendars, and Bell Schedules are easier to find. A new Parents & Students tab surfaces the most-requested information.
- **Improved “Our Schools”:** Families can now search by address, school name, school type or program, or using an interactive map view.
- **Clearer navigation:** Bolder, more obvious clickable elements and added menu tiers make it simpler and faster to browse. Improvements are based on user data—what people search for and which pages they visit most.
- **Updated look and feel:** Colours, fonts, and branding align with the division and schools' visual identity.
- **Vision & Values:** New Our Commitment & Vision content and a Land Acknowledgement better reflect the division's values.
- **Programs page:** Information about specialized programming is consolidated in one location to make discovery easier.

A feedback form is available on the new sites so visitors can share suggestions. Minor adjustments and refinements will continue over the coming weeks.

The transition to the new platform began this morning. As is typical with web updates, it may take some time for the new website to appear when called up from various locations and using different devices.
