Tommy Douglas improv troupe heading to nationals after provincial win

Saskatoon Public Schools is excited to announce that Tommy Douglas Collegiate’s improvisation performance troupe, Skits & Giggles, is heading to Ottawa to compete at the national level after winning the provincial title on March 7, 2026, in Regina.

The group will face teams from across the country at the [Canadian Improv Games](#), taking place at Ottawa’s National Arts Centre from April 15–18, 2026.

“I couldn’t be prouder of our improv students and teachers here at Tommy Douglas,” says principal Kevin McNarland. “We’re the only competitive improv group in Saskatoon, and they competed against more than a dozen teams from Regina and across the province to earn this opportunity. I knew this group was strong, and now others across the country will get to see that too.”

Mike Prebble, the troupe’s head coach, says the team’s success reflects the dedication and talent of the students.

“We’re thrilled for this opportunity for our students, our school, and the division,” says Prebble. “The teams in the provincial event are always talented and make for some tough competition. I’m incredibly pleased to see these students earn this chance at nationals. They’ve worked hard for it.”

Before departing for Ottawa, the troupe will share one more local performance (alongside four other teams) at the Saskatoon Night of Improv:
