Through song, dance, and shared celebration, the event honours Treaty relationships, Indigenous cultures, and the ongoing commitment to Treaty education within Saskatoon Public Schools. The Round Dance provides a welcoming space to gather, celebrate, and strengthen connections with one another and with the teachings that continue to guide us today.

The gathering is being complemented by Treaty education and learning opportunities taking place in classrooms before and after the event. Students will also be adding their tiles to a Treaty 6 mosaic during the event.
