Saskatoon Public Schools honouring Indigenous Veterans Day, Remembrance Day

Saskatoon Public Schools is honouring National Indigenous Veterans Day (Nov. 8) and Remembrance Day (Nov. 11) with school ceremonies and by lowering school flags to half-mast.

Flags will be lowered at the end of the day today in recognition of Indigenous Veterans Day tomorrow. This is a day to remember the service and sacrifices of Indigenous veterans—acknowledging that, for many years, their contributions were often overlooked in mainstream commemorations.

Flags will remain at half-mast for Remembrance Day, honouring those who have served and sacrificed for their country in times of war and peace. Flags will be raised again on the morning of November 12.

Many schools across the division are holding ceremonies today, and families are welcome to attend.
