

SASKATOON PUBLIC SCHOOLS BUDGET REDUCTIONS

Budget Reductions Since 2016-17



The Grade 8 Home Economics and Industrial Arts programs were discontinued in 2019-20.



20 school-based secretarial positions have been eliminated.



45 central office positions have been eliminated.



Reduction in transportation services, resulting in an increased walk distance and complete removal of transportation in certain neighbourhoods.



School-based and central office budget lines have been reduced significantly in recent years.



Reduction or elimination of student support positions in the following categories:



Teacher librarians



EAL teachers



Educational psychologists

Note: Teacher librarian positions in schools have been eliminated. The school division employs three teacher librarians to manage the library collection in all 59 schools.

Did you know?

In 2016-17, high school enrolment was 8,558 students with 520 teachers. In 2023-24, high school enrolment is 9,031 students with 480 teachers.
